Mosquito control in Antis Township, Blair Township, and Hollidaysburg Borough to reduce nuisance mosquito populations.

The Blair County Mosquito-borne Disease Control Program will be conducting a truck-mounted ultra-low volume (ULV) mosquito control operation in areas of Antis Township, Blair Township, and Hollidaysburg Borough to reduce populations of nuisance mosquitoes and mosquitoes capable of transmitting West Nile Virus on Thursday, September 10th, 2026. ***The previously scheduled adult control operation on September 3rd, 2026, was cancelled due to weather. The makeup control operation on September 8th, 2026, was cancelled due to equipment malfunctions.***

This control work will begin around dusk.

Areas include but are not limited to: Antis Township, Blair Township, and Hollidaysburg Borough.

High populations of nuisance mosquitoes have been found in these areas. Other areas within close proximity may also be treated.

Weather conditions and other unexpected events could delay or cancel the spray operations. If these operations are cancelled, they will be rescheduled for Friday, September 11th, 2026.

Residents are asked to stay indoors while the truck-mounted spray is conducted in their neighborhoods. Blair County staff have a policy of turning off the sprayer as a courtesy when residents are outside during a spray. The more often the spray is turned off, the less effective the operation will be at reducing mosquitoes and West Nile Virus in a given neighborhood.

The product being used for this operation is Biomist 3+15 ULV at a rate of 0.75oz/acre and will be associated with a white Ford F-350 and BU1560.

There will be alternate equipment present in case of another equipment malfunction. The alternate product being used for the operation is AquaDuet at a rate of 0.67oz/acre and will be associated with a white Ford F-150 and BU5976.
